

**CITY OF MANZANITA
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

PURPOSE: Provide citizen input and actively identify safety issues to City Council on policy matters related to law enforcement, fire protection and emergency management jurisdictions within the City of Manzanita area and other public safety matters referred to it by the City Council.

DUTIES:

1. Study auto, bike, skateboard, and pedestrian traffic safety matters as problems are identified and develop recommendations for addressing them.
2. Examine non-traffic related law enforcement and/or fire protection issues affecting all of or certain areas of the City and develop recommendations for addressing them.
3. Review major policy changes regarding the organization and delivery of law enforcement, fire protection, and emergency management services.
4. Review programs and activities designed to increase the public's awareness of emergency preparedness including, but not limited to, recruiting volunteers for emergency activities and organizing community meetings for emergency preparedness education.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Committee shall consist of seven voting members appointed by the City Council. Members are appointed by the Mayor and serve at the pleasure of the City Council. Terms of appointment shall be no longer than four years. A member of the Manzanita City Council shall be an ex officio member and shall act as the Committee's liaison to the City Council.
